# Graduation Impossible Fold Card



**G**raduation Card Featuring the Impossible Fold

## Supplies needed:

- Large Numbers Framelits Dies [140622]
- Crushed Curry 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock [131199]
- Basic Black 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock [121045]
- Cherry Cobbler 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock [119685]
- Whisper White 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock [100730]

## Project Recipe:

1. Base : 4 1/4" x 5 1/2"

Score @ 2 1/8" on the 4 1/4" side

Cut @ 2 3/4" on the 5 1/2" side from the top to the score line

Cut @ 3/4" from each end on the 5 1/2" side from the bottom to the score line

2. Mat Layer 1: 2 5/8" x 4 1/8" (2 pieces needed)

Score @ 5/8" on the 2 5/8" side

Cut @ 2" on the 4 1/8" side from the edge furthest from the score line to the score line

Cut the larger square off by cutting on the score line.

3. Top Layer: 2 1/2" x 4" (2 pieces needed)

Score @ 1/2" on the 2 1/2" side

Cut @ 1 7/8" on the 4" side starting from the edge furthest from the score line to the score line.

Cut on the score line to remove the larger square.

4. Front Layers for Pop-Up (2018 in picture)

Mat Layer: 2" x 3 7/8"

Top Layer: 1 7/8" x 3 3/4"

5. Stabilizer Strip: 5 1/2" x 3/4"

6. Impossible Fold:

Lay the base piece down with the center cut at the bottom.

Fold the top piece up.

Take the bottom right corner and rotate it to the back - so the big square is behind the pop-up and the thin piece is now at the bottom.

7. Adhere the layers to the base and decorate as desired.
