

## Daisy Friend Card

Base: Mint Macaron 4 ¼" x 11"

Whisper White – (1) 4" x 5 ¼", (1) 4" x 4", scrap for die cuts and punch

Mint Macaron scrap for die cut

- 1) Score the base at 5 ½" on the 11" side.
- 2) Cut 1 ¼" off from the bottom of the front panel
- 3) Ink the Birch Stamp in Crumb Cake ink and stamp on 4" x 4" Whisper White
- 4) Use the largest Scallop Square in the Layering Squares set to die cut a piece of Mint Macaron
- 5) Stamp the large Daisy from Daisy Lane in Mint Macaron on a scrap of white – die cut with largest Stitched Square
- 6) Stamp large Daisy on scrap of Whisper White and punch with Large Daisy punch
- 7) Stamp Friend in Crumb Cake Ink on bottom of 4" x 5 ¼" Whisper White
- 8) Attach 4" x 5 ¼" Whisper White to inside of card
- 9) Attach the birch 4" x 4" on the front of the card
- 10) Attach die cut stitched square to Mint Macaron Scallop Square
- 11) Attach punched Daisy to stamped daisy on stitched square
- 12) Stamp Bee from Honey Bee Bundle to scrap of Whisper White with Memento Black ink
- 13) Color stripes with Daffodil Delight Dark Stampin' Blend
- 14) Use Wink of Stella to glitter the center of Daisy and the Bee's wings
- 15) Die cut with coordinating die
- 16) Attach Scalloped Square to Birch layer using Dimensionals
- 17) Attach Bee to lower left corner of the daisy.

## Daisy Tri-Flap Fold Card:

Base – Early Espresso 4 ¼" x 11"

Designer Series Paper – (2) 2 ½" x 4", (3) ¾" x 3 ¾"

Coordinating Card stock: (3) 1" x 4"

Whisper White – 4" x 5 ¼" (Inside)

- 1) Score the base at 2 ¾" from both ends – fold in – the ends should meet in the middle
- 2) Attach the 2 ½" x 4" pieces to the two front sides
- 3) Attach the DSP strips to the Coordinating Card Stock strips
- 4) Place the 3 strips on the front of the card – equally spaced apart.
- 5) Attach the top and bottom strip to the left hand side only.
- 6) Attach the middle strip to the right hand side only.
- 7) Stamp the Daisy in Night of Navy Ink on Whisper White.
- 8) Punch the stamped daisy, a plain Whisper White Daisy and a Night of Navy Daisy
- 9) Adhere the three daisies together to make one daisy
- 10) Stamp the small center in Soft Sea Foam and attach to center of Daisy
- 11) Lay the Daisy on the right hand side. Gently pick up the flaps and open the panel so you can see where to adhere the daisy to the top and bottom flaps only – leaving enough room to slide the center flap between the left edge and the daisy.
- 12) Add sentiment and embellishment to middle flap on the left side
